The latest updates on the community pool

Fall is here and the pumpkin spice is in the air. Here is what is going on at the pool this fall.

- 1. November 1st the pool is switching to winter hours. The winter hours will be from 10am 6pm.
 - a. Remember, if you have early morning swim (6am 10am), this is for adults only.
- 2. The pool monitors have gone back into hibernation till June of 2024. If you have key problems or want to use the pool for a party, please contact president@mvhoa2.org.
- 3. We do have one year-round pool monitor that cleans once or twice a week and takes out the trash and cleans out the pet trashcans.
- 4. We have upgraded the irrigation system for the lawn. It is now weather controlled and senses the moisture in the air and adjusts the run time of the sprinklers or shuts them off if there is too much moisture in the ground already. This should save us a lot on water bills and overwatering.

If you see someone climbing the fence of the pool, please call the HOA voicemail line at 858-566-2821. We have cameras now and if we know when they climbed the fence, we can find the recording and give it to the police to prosecute for trespassing.

Please, also stop opening the door for people whose keys are not working. They are usually turned off for a reason.
